Rear Seat-back Lock Is Hard to Turn

SYMPTOM

The rear seat-back lock is hard to turn.

PROBABLE CAUSE

Not enough lubricant on the rear seat-back latch.

CORRECTIVE ACTION

Remove the rear seat-back latch, lubricate it, and reinstall it.

REQUIRED MATERIALS

White Lithium Grease (aerosol): P/N 08732-0005 (Each can of grease will repair about 25 vehicles.)


WARRANTY CLAIM INFORMATION

The normal warranty applies.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

- Remove the latch assembly from the rear seat-back as described in the Body section of the 1998 Accord Shop Manual.
- 2. Lubricate the latch assembly:



- 3. Reinstall the latch assembly in the vehicle.
- 4. Make sure that the seat-back lock turns smoothly and the seat-back latch operates properly.
